They are working in collaboration with United Way of SC to continue responding to this bill (G2, O5 &amp; O6).</li> <li>• Parent Engagement Committee heard reports that the “Ready 4K” parent texting program was going well for GCSD participants (G1, O1).</li> <li>• Members helped ECC steering committee present a training event to early childcare providers (G2, O1).</li> <li>• Members participated in applying for a <i>Healthy Communities</i> grant that if funded could incorporate GCAT collective impact initiatives (G2, O3).</li> </ul>

<p>Early Childhood Physicians Advisory Council (ECPAC)</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plan to reach out to Coastal Montessori and Teach My People as possible sites for exploring the uses of Telehealth in non-health care settings to assist with student health.</li> <li>Plan to explore the possible use of Triple P- Level 3 (brief consultative services) with the Georgetown County pediatric community.</li> </ul>
<p>Early Childcare Collaborative (ECC)</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Members attended ELC meetings (G1, O1).</li> <li>Presented a training session and business meeting for directors and staff of early childcare facilities in Georgetown County on February 23, 2017. (G1, O2, G2, O2)</li> <li>Discussed participating with other groups to explore resource sharing regarding the use of Triple P (G1, O3).</li> </ul>
<p>Cross Collaborative Service Coordinators/Case Managers Group</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Finalized 6 common questions that members of the collaborative plan to ask their clients. At the next meeting they plan to discuss how to use a data-sharing platform on which to share the answers to these questions. They plan to begin collecting data to discuss at their June 2017 meeting.</li> <li>Discussed the HCCCY and RISE referral processes. Some organizations have experienced success.</li> <li>Planned to have a Triple P presentation at their next meeting.</li> </ul>
