<p>Early Learning Council</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Met with other community leaders to plan a Countywide community visioning conversation to be led by the Coastal Community Foundation on April 17, 2018 (G3, O1). • Advocacy committee is keeping track of a SC Bill to create a Department of Children’s Advocacy. They have a plan to ask local child advocates to support the bill (G2, O2). • Planned an event for the Early Childcare Collaborative to provide information about the Palmetto Shared Services Alliance (G2, O1).

The data collected will determine if service to children and youth increases from year to year (G1, O1). • Discussed HCCCY involvement in educational opportunities provided by members, grant participation opportunities, and Triple P participation. • Planned to use meeting time to hear about members’ programs. • Served as the CAB for Healthy Families Georgetown.

The Institute for Child Success has also offered five scholarships for Georgetown County early childcare programs.

Plan to explore overarching goals from the Spartanburg Communitywide roll out of Triple P.
