All young people in the Southern Georgetown Community will be successful ,productive citizens.

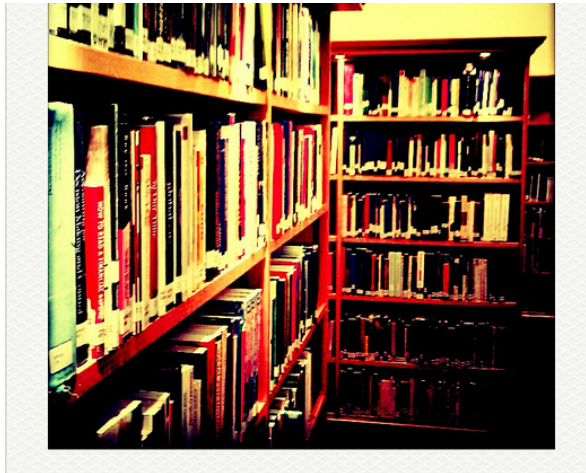


## Goal 1
