<b>Other Criteria:</b> No income limit, must be pregnant to start receiving services.	<b>Other Criteria:</b> Cannot have an income greater than 80% of Georgetown County median income.	<b>Other Criteria:</b> Clients must enroll before the baby is 3 months old.

<b>Services:</b> Education, home visiting program, literacy enrichment to family child cares and unlicensed and unregistered “neighborhood babysitters.”	<b>Services:</b> Education, health care, basic needs, home visits, service coordination, information and referrals, home visiting, Family center care, economic self-sufficiency, evidence-based model, BSN prepared RN’s, CLC certified nurses, Safe Sleep certified, trained in Motivational Interviewing	<b>Services:</b> Education, health care, basic needs, information and referrals, breastfeeding classes, childbirth classes, CPR for new parents and grandparents, Women and Children’s Unit tours, infant care classes, lactation consultation, sibling classes
<b>Other Criteria:</b> Must complete 2 years in the program. Program must have adult (18+ yrs. old) participation, Family must be under resourced. Income along with other qualifying issues considered.	<b>Other Criteria:</b> if do not qualify to participate in the study will be referred to other agencies approved at state level.	<b>Other Criteria:</b> no income restrictions
